

Information for Residents on Road Access during the Iron Man Race, Sunday 16 July 2017

IRONMAN UK operates under road closures provided by the Special Events Act, which allows the closure of public highway to allow events to be held. The information provided below and on the map of the race course should clarify the access available at various times which will enable residents and visitors to plan in advance to minimise any impact that the event may have.

ADLINGTON & ANDERTON: 6.30am until 4.30pm

Travel is possible through Adlington as normal along the A6 Westhoughton Rd northbound and southbound. However delays may be experienced at these times. To maintain the safety of road users and athletes, in the centre of Adlington between Babylon Lane and Rawlinson Lane, motorists are only permitted to travel north not south through the village.

See the map of the course through the village that motorists will be able to take.
