

## Changes to Bus Services – January 2019

### Service

#### ROSSENDALE SERVICES continued

Each service will generally run every two hours, providing a combined hourly service between Rawtenstall and Bacup. The section of the routes between Rawtenstall & Bacup and through to Todmorden will continue to operate in partnership with Lancashire County Council.

#### 10 Rawtenstall – Edgeside

This service will be withdrawn and replaced by new Services 7 & 8.

#### 13 Rawtenstall – New Hall Hey Circular (ROS leaflet)

There will be minor timetable changes.

#### 446/447 Wallbank – Rochdale (ROS leaflet)

The timetable will be revised.

#### 463 Bacup – Burnley

This service will be withdrawn and replaced by new Services 7 & 8.

#### 464 Accrington – Haslingden – Rawtenstall – Bacup – Rochdale (ROS leaflet)

There will be minor timetable changes. Certain am/pm peak time schoolday journeys will run by unbranded buses renumbered to 864.

#### 465/466 Rawtenstall - Bacup - Todmorden

These service will be withdrawn and replaced by new Services 7 & 8.

### Service

#### 481 Bury – Rawtenstall – Haslingden – Blackburn

#### 483 Bury – Rawtenstall – Water – Burnley (ROS leaflet)

These services will be relaunched with updated buses. New timetables will apply with a combined 15 minute Monday to Saturday daytime frequency between Rawtenstall & Bury with hourly extensions to Blackburn and Burnley.

#### 482 Bury – Rawtenstall – Bacup

This service will be withdrawn. Customers can continue to travel by using Service 464 between Bacup and Rawtenstall to connect with more frequent services 481 and 483 at Rawtenstall Bus Station. Pennine Road will be replaced by new Services 7 & 8.

# bus service changes

## January 2019



This leaflet has been produced by Lancashire County Council. It is issued at the beginning of each month to help you keep up-to-date with changes made to bus services in the county.

Service

**LANCASTER SERVICES**

From **13 January 2019** Stagecoach in Lancaster will introduce the following revisions to their bus services:

**1 Lancaster University – Lancaster – Morecambe – Heysham (STL leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting times to improve overall service reliability.

**2 Lancaster University – Hala – Lancaster – Bare – Morecambe (STL leaflet)**

The route and timetable will be revised, introducing double deck buses onto the route to increase customer capacity and times will be adjusted to improve overall service reliability.

The route will be amended between Lancaster and Torrisholme to operate via Greyhound Bridge, Morecambe Road and Scale Hall Lane, avoiding the low bridge on Torrisholme Road in Skerton,

The section of Torrisholme Road in Skerton and Ryelands will continue to be served by alternative local bus Services 7 & 8. Stagecoach will introduce additional Monday to Saturday Service 7 evening journeys (see below for details).

**2X Lancaster – Heysham – Morecambe (STL leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting times to improve overall service reliability.

**4/4X Lancaster University – Lancaster – Railway Station (STL leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting times to improve overall service reliability.

Service

**7 Lancaster – Vale – Lancaster (STL leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, introducing additional later Monday to Saturday evening journeys to partially replace the revised Service 2 route on Torrisholme Road in Skerton. The additional Monday to Saturday departures from Lancaster will be at 1915, 2015, 2115 & 2300.

**WYRE SERVICES**

From **6 January 2019** Blackpool Transport will introduce the following revisions to their bus services:

**2C Blackpool – Poulton – Knott End (BLA leaflet)**

The route and timetable will be revised, adjusting the service in Preesall to operate via Pilling Lane and Grasmere Road during opening hours of the Over Wyre Medical Centre. All other journeys will operate direct via Lancaster Road.

**7 Cleveleys – Blackpool – St. Annes (BLA leaflet)**

The route and timetable will be revised, adjusting the service in St. Annes Town Centre to operate via Clifton Drive South, Links Road and South Promenade to improve connectivity with Service 17.

**PRESTON SERVICES**

From **6 January 2019** Stagecoach in Merseyside and South Lancashire will introduce the following revisions to their bus services:

Service

**1/1A Preston – Ribbleton – Grimsargh – Longridge**

The timetable will be revised, with minor amendments to the late night journeys.

**2/2A Preston – Tarleton – Southport/Ormskirk**

The route and timetable will be revised, adjusting the Service 2A route in Burscough to operate direct along the A59 Liverpool Road, no longer serving Trevor Road and Truscott Road.

**3 Preston – Penwortham – Kingsfold**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting the 0535 Monday to Friday journey to depart at 0530 and operate 5 minutes earlier throughout.

**4 Preston – Preston College – Fulwood – Whittingham – Longridge – (Chipping)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday AM peak journey times to improve overall service reliability.

**9 Preston – New Hall Lane – Moor Nook**

The route and timetable will be revised, adjusting the 0756 Monday to Friday Schooldays journey from Moor Nook to extend from the Bus Station to additionally serve Frenchwood Christ the King RCHS. This will assist with capacity issues on School Service 721.

**59/59C Preston – Mellor Brook – Blackburn – (Accrington)**

The journeys that operate along Mellor Brook Branch Road will be amended to stop on a Hail & Ride basis.

Service

**61/61C Preston – Kirkham – Blackpool**

The timetable will be revised, with adjustments to journey times to improve overall service reliability.

**113 Preston – Bamber Bridge – Lostock Hall – Leyland – Eccleston – Wigan (LCC leaflet)**

From **7 January 2019** following the decision by Stagecoach in Merseyside and South Lancashire to withdraw this service, Lancashire County Council will introduce a full replacement tendered bus service.

There will be some minor amendments to the timetable with Stagecoach in Merseyside and South Lancashire continuing to operate the service on behalf of Lancashire County Council.

**125 Preston – Bamber Bridge – Chorley – Horwich – Bolton**

The timetable will be revised, with minor adjustments to journey times to improve overall service reliability.

**PRESTON SERVICES**

From **21 January 2019** Rotala Preston Bus will introduce the following revisions to their bus services:

**5 Preston – Fulwood (PBT leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, withdrawing the 0639 & 0724 Monday to Friday early morning direct journeys from Preston to Fulwood.

Service

**14 Preston – Holme Slack (PBT leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, withdrawing the following journeys:  
0625 Monday to Friday journey from Holme Slack to Preston. Alternative journey available at 0705;  
0735 Saturday journey from Holme Slack to Preston. Alternative journey available at 0805;  
0752 Saturday journey from Preston to Holme Slack. Alternative journey available at 0822.

**19 Preston – Deepdale – Royal Preston Hospital (PBT leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability. The Saturday daytime timetable will be reduced to operate every 15 minutes.

**23 Preston – Fulwood – Royal Preston Hospital – Asda (PBT leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability.

**31 Preston – Savick – Lea (PBT leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, adjusting the Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability, with a slightly reduced early evening frequency. The Saturday daytime timetable will be reduced to operate every 20 minutes.

Service

**35 Preston – Tanterton (PBT leaflet)**

The timetable will be revised, reducing the Saturday daytime timetable to operate every 12 minutes.

**88 Larches – Cottam – Fulwood – Royal Preston Hospital (PBT leaflet)**

The route and timetable will be revised, restoring the original route by adjusting the service to no longer serve Savick or extend through to Preston College. The timetable will be adjusted to operate every 30 minutes during the AM/PM peak but hourly during the off-peak (0900-1500).

**ROSSENDALE SERVICES**

From **27 January 2019**, Rosso will introduce the following revisions to their bus services:

**7 Rawtenstall – Bacup – Todmorden  
8 Rawtenstall – Bacup – Burnley (ROS leaflet)**

These new services will replace Services 10, 463, 465/466 and the Pennine Road section of 482.

The services will operate as follows:

Service 7: Rawtenstall – Newchurch – Waterfoot – Edgeside – Booth Road – Newline – Pennine Road – Bacup – Sharneyford – Cloughfoot – Todmorden

Service 8: Rawtenstall – Newchurch – Waterfoot – Edgeside – Booth Road – Newline – Pennine Road – Bacup – Weir – Towneley – Burnley
