Changes to Bus Services – April 2017

Service

LANCASTER SERVICES

555 Lancaster – Kendal – Keswick (STC leaflet)

From **8 April 2017** Stagecoach in Cumbria will revise the timetable, adjusting a number of journeys for the summer season.

755 Heysham – Morecambe – Carnforth – Kendal – Windermere – Bowness (STL leaflet)

From **8 April 2017** Stagecoach in Lancaster will revise the timetable, adjusting a number of journeys for the summer season.

FYLDE & WYRE SERVICES

1 Fleetwood – Cleveleys – Blackpool – Starr Gate (BLA leaflet)

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will revise the timetable for the Summer Season, enhancing the daytime service to every 20 minutes.

2 Blackpool – Victoria Hospital – Poulton – Carleton – Cleveleys (BLA leaflet)

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will introduce this new service to partially replace withdrawn Services 10/17 between Blackpool and Poulton. Monday to Saturday daytime frequency will be half hourly between Blackpool and Poulton

extending hourly through to Cleveleys via Carleton Arundel Drive and Thornton Four Lane Ends.

2C Blackpool – Victoria Hospital – Poulton – Knott End (BLA leaflet)

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will revise the Sunday timetable, coordinating with new Service 2 between Blackpool and Poulton.

7 Lytham – St. Annes – Blackpool – Cleveleys (BLA leaflet)

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will revise the timetable, adjusting journeys and increasing the general Monday to Saturday daytime frequency from every 20 minutes to every 15 minutes for the Summer Season.

8 Cleveleys – Victoria Hospital (BLA leaflet)

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will withdraw this service, although the link between Cleveleys and Victoria Hospital will be maintained by the new Service 2.

9 Cleveleys – Blackpool (BLA leaflet)

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will revise the route and timetable, reinstating the normal route following reopening of Plymouth

Road Bridge. The Monday to Saturday daytime frequency increased to every 12 minutes for the Summer Season.

**10 St. Annes – Blackpool –
Victoria Hospital – Poulton
(BLA leaflet)**

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will withdraw this service, although the majority of the service within Lancashire's boundaries will be replaced by the new Service 2 and the enhanced Service 17.

**14 Fleetwood – Thornton –
Blackpool
(BLA leaflet)**

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the service to operate between Fleetwood and Blackpool only. The section of route within Blackpool, between Blackpool and Mereside will be replaced by a new Service 6.

**17 Blackpool – Spring Gardens –
St. Annes
(BLA leaflet)**

From **2 April 2017** Blackpool Transport will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the service to operate between Blackpool and St. Annes only on an increased frequency to partially replace Service 10. The section of route between Blackpool and Poulton will be replaced by a new Service 2.

**21 St. Annes – Blackpool –
Cleveleys (OAK leaflet)**

From **14 April 2017** Catch22bus Ltd will revise the timetable, adjusting journeys and increasing the general frequency for the Summer Season.

**68 Preston – Lytham –
St. Annes – Blackpool (STG leaflet)**

From **2 April 2017** Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the timetable, adjusting journeys and increasing the general Monday to Saturday daytime frequency from every 20 minutes to every 15 minutes for the Summer Season.

PRESTON SERVICES

**X2 Preston – Southport – Liverpool
(STG leaflet)**

From **30 April 2017** Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the timetable, adjusting certain Monday to Friday am peak journey times to improve overall service reliability.

**X8 Chorley – Preston –
Windermere – Keswick
(STG leaflet)**

From **8 April 2017** Stagecoach in Lancashire will reintroduce this service for the summer season. Operating Saturdays only, the service departs Chorley at 0920 and Preston 0950, through Clayton Brook & Bamber Bridge. Returning from Keswick at 1630 and Windermere at 1730.

SOUTH RIBBLE SERVICES

**113 Preston – Bamber Bridge –
Leyland – Ecclestone – Wigan
(STG leaflet)**

From **30 April 2017** Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the timetable, adjusting certain individual Monday to Friday journey times to improve overall service reliability.

WEST LANCASHIRE SERVICES

**300 Liverpool – Halsall – Southport
(Merseytravel leaflet)**

From **23 April 2017** Arriva Merseyside will revise the whole timetable whilst maintaining general frequency and periods of operation.

**310 Liverpool – Ormskirk –
Skelmersdale
(Merseytravel leaflet)**

From **23 April 2017** Arriva Merseyside will revise the timetable, adjusting the Sunday service to operate between Liverpool and Maghull only and no longer running through to Ormskirk and Skelmersdale. There are no changes to the Monday to Saturday service operating through Ormskirk and Skelmersdale.

**8A Chorley – Limbrick –
Lower Adlington – Blackrod
(STG leaflet)**

From **30 April 2017** Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the timetable, increasing the number of Saturday return journeys from two to four. Journeys will depart Chorley at 0915, 1030, 1150 & 1350 and depart Blackrod at 0945, 1100, 1220 & 1420. There will also be an additional Monday to Friday journey at 1030 from Chorley to Blackrod.
