



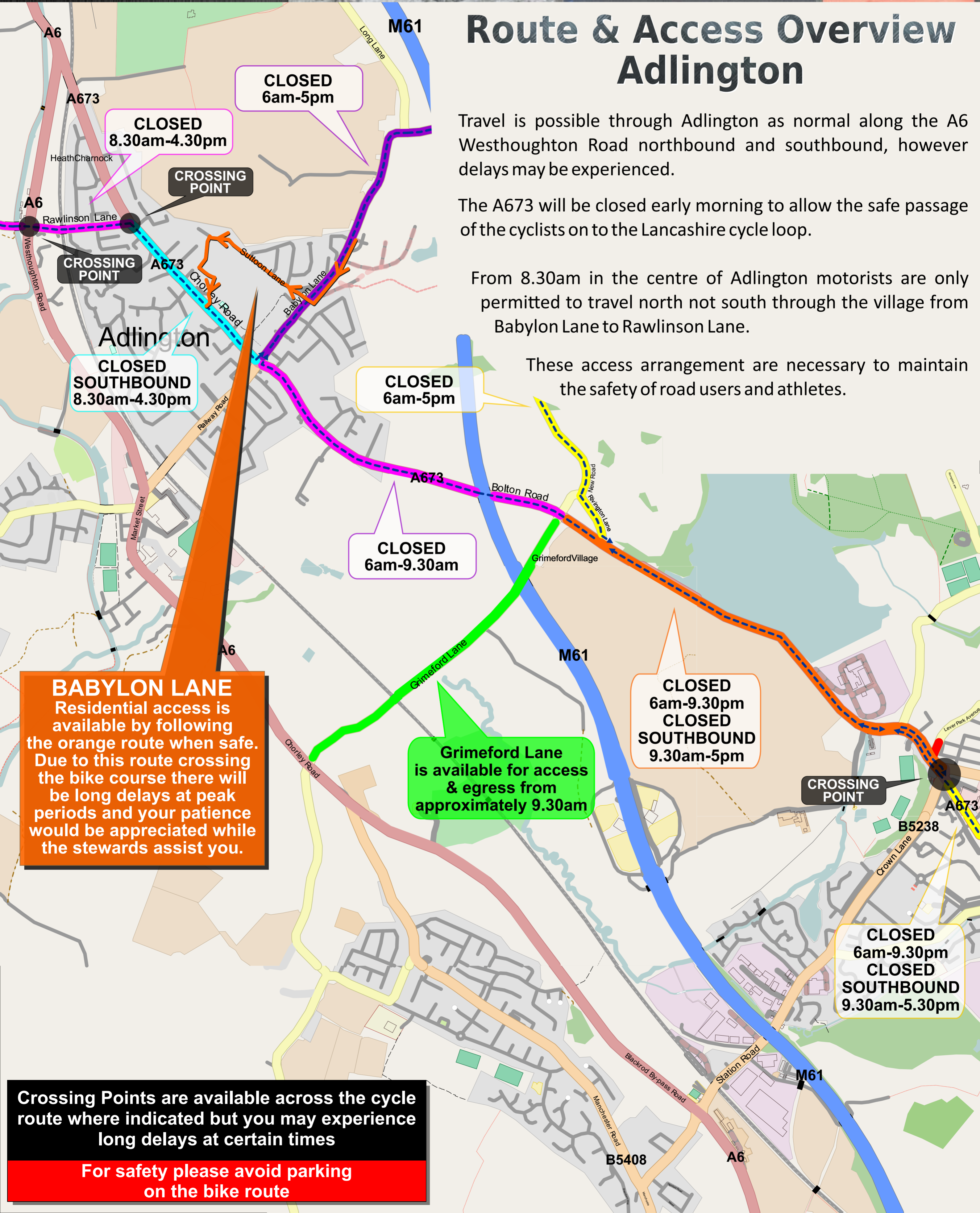
Route & Access Overview Adlington

Travel is possible through Adlington as normal along the A6 Westhoughton Road northbound and southbound, however delays may be experienced.

The A673 will be closed early morning to allow the safe passage of the cyclists on to the Lancashire cycle loop.

From 8.30am in the centre of Adlington motorists are only permitted to travel north not south through the village from Babylon Lane to Rawlinson Lane.

These access arrangements are necessary to maintain the safety of road users and athletes.



BABYLON LANE
 Residential access is available by following the orange route when safe. Due to this route crossing the bike course there will be long delays at peak periods and your patience would be appreciated while the stewards assist you.

Grimeford Lane is available for access & egress from approximately 9.30am

Crossing Points are available across the cycle route where indicated but you may experience long delays at certain times

For safety please avoid parking on the bike route
