

Online PACT – What is it all about then?

Online PACT (Police And Communities Together) is your opportunity to express your concerns to Chorley's Neighbourhood Policing Team about local policing issues.

It gives people who might not ordinarily contact police in other ways such as attending PACT meetings or drop in surgeries the chance to give their view on what they would like local Policing teams to concentrate on.

Between a certain time (Adlington, Heath Charnock & Rivington between 17:00 – 19:00) both the Chorley Police Twitter & Facebook accounts will be permanently monitored by staff who can respond to your concerns.

Any issues raised will either be given an immediate response in terms of how local policing teams intend to address the issue, or where further research on the problem is necessary it will be passed to the team for that area.

When reporting issues please be mindful of privacy issues as you are posting information on a publicly available forum so do not name any individuals believed to be responsible for any specific crime or problem you are concerned about, speak generally about the nature of the problem and we can obtain further details later on out of public view.
