(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY ONE WAY TRAFFIC)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING)  
ORDER 2017**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle or cycle (except for Triathlon participants) from proceeding over those lengths of road, in Chorley, specified in the first column, of grid 1, of the Schedule to this Notice.

Alternative routes for vehicular traffic and cyclists affected by the closures will be signed locally.

Access will be maintained via marshal points for residents and businesses.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to enable the holding of the Bolton Ironman UK Triathlon event.

The prohibition will be operative between 0600 hours and 1700 hours on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2017. (Or, at such time as, the last competitor has passed a point specified in the first column of the schedule to this notice.)

**AND FURTHER**, during the period of the event, between 0600 hours and 1700 hours, motor vehicles and cycles will be temporarily prohibited from proceeding over the lengths of road specified in the first column, of grid 2, in the direction as specified in the first column, of grid 2, of the Schedule to this Notice.

**AND FURTHER**, during the period of the event, between 0600 hours and 1700 hours, motor vehicles and cycles (except for Triathlon participants) will be temporarily prohibited from making a right turn manoeuvre over those lengths of road, in Chorley, specified in grid 3, of the Schedule to this Notice.

**AND FURTHER**, during the period of the event, between 0600 hours and 1700 hours, motor vehicles and cycles will be temporarily prohibited from waiting on those lengths of road, in Chorley, specified in the first column, of grid 4, of the Schedule to this Notice.
